

**AVTANSKI, Dimiter Ph.D.**

Dimiter Avtanski is a Director of the Endocrine Research Laboratory at Friedman Diabetes Institute, Associate Professor of Medicine at Donald and Barbara Zucker School of Medicine at Hofstra/Northwell in Hempstead, New York, and Assistant Professor at the Center for Biomedical Science at Feinstein Institutes for Medical Research in Manhasset, New York. Dr. Avtanski received his M.Sc. degree in Biology and Chemistry from Sofia University in Bulgaria and his Ph.D. degree from the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences in collaboration with Beth Israel Medical Center at Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York City. Before joining Friedman Diabetes Institute, Dr. Avtanski specialized at Leipzig University, Germany and completed seven years of post-doctoral fellowships at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine in Baltimore, Maryland. His main research focuses on the interaction between obesity, diabetes, carcinogenesis, and steroidogenesis. Dr. Avtanski serves as Associate Editor for Molecular Medicine journal and is Editorial Board Member for several other scientific journals. He is actively reviewing for variety of journals and has multiple recognitions for his reviewing activity. Dr. Avtanski is a research mentor of rotating fellows from Lenox Hill Hospital, Hofstra University and Feinstein Institute for Medical Research.
